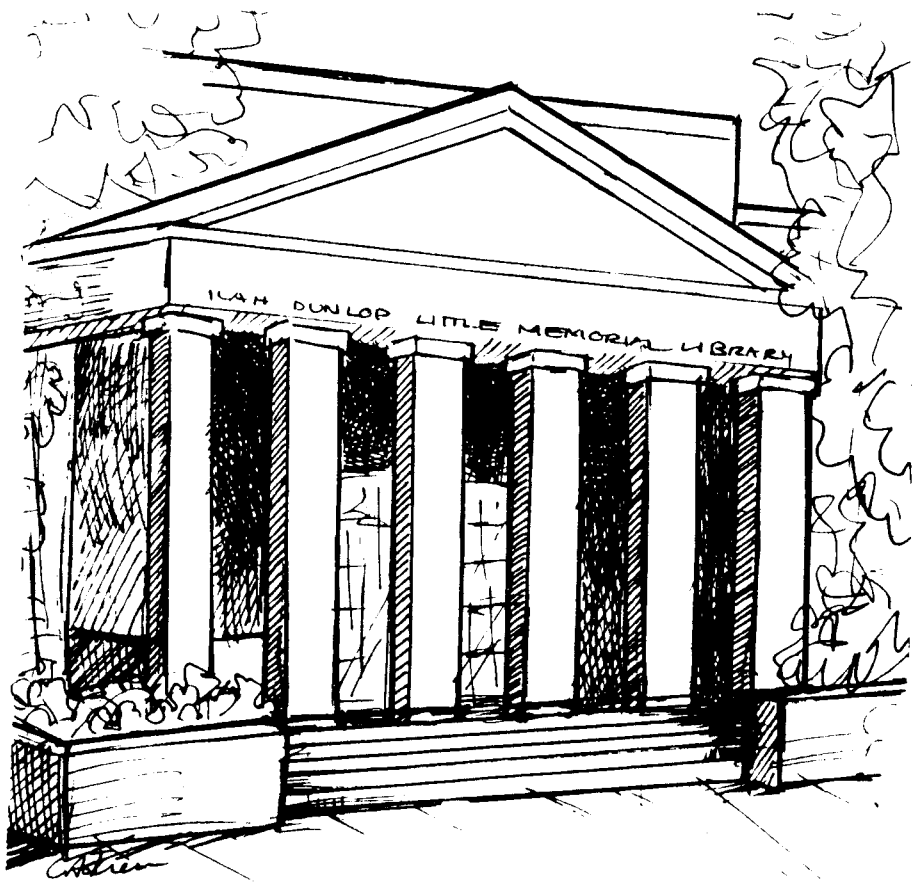

SUPERVISOR OF THE YEAR

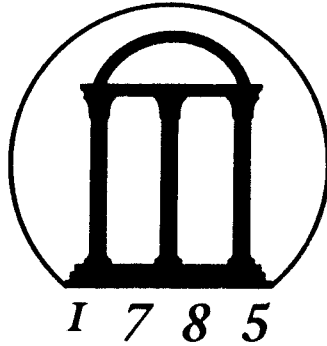
