BEFORE YOU COME TO DO RESEARCH IN THE RUSSELL LIBRARY

Please follow these steps as you begin your search for primary materials in the Russell Library:

- **Do some basic background reading to help you narrow down an aspect of the period to pursue** (see areas listed below)
- **Come to the Russell Library** and browse the collection inventories to determine if material is present related to your preferred topic.
- **Complete some background reading** using secondary sources on your topic area
- **Create a rough timeline** for your topic with key dates
- **Create a list of key participants**
- Bring the timeline and the list of key people with you when you return to do research. This information will help you choose a primary source(s) that can effectively anchor your paper project.
- Bring a picture id with you.
- **You may bring a laptop** for note-taking
- **Requests for photocopying are limited and copies cost 25 cents** (we accept cash or checks).
- Remember feel free to **ask questions about anything**
