

[S.T.E.P.] HR Tips: UGA's Hotline

Did you know that if you see or suspect unethical or illegal behavior on campus, you may report your concerns anonymously through the University of Georgia's hotline? The University's Ethics and Compliance Reporting System hotline is independently operated and available 24/7 to UGA faculty and staff via The Network, a technology-based company specializing in online reporting systems and state-of-the art call centers.

What you can report: Any activity by UGA or a UGA employee that violates Board of Regents and/or UGA policy, any state or federal law, or involves waste of resources or of misconduct.

How to report: Call The Network at 1-877-516-3467 toll-free, 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, or file a report online at <https://www.reportlineweb.com/Welcome.aspx?Client=UGA>.
