- ✘ To search GALILEO from off-campus, go to “GALILEO password” on the Libraries’ homepage. The password changes every semester.

Literary Criticism

GIL <<http://gil.uga.edu>> : Searches the UGA Libraries Catalog. For literary criticism, choose ‘Exact Search,’ type in the author’s name (last name, then first name) and select the Subject Heading search. Look for the subheading of “Criticism and Interpretation.” To search for criticism of a particular work, choose “Keyword Search,” type in the title and author, and select “Subject” at the right.

JSTOR and **Project Muse** (GALILEO): Includes searchable full text of a small collection of scholarly journals; JSTOR has older journals going up to five years ago, and Project Muse has more recent issues.

MLA Bibliography (GALILEO): Indexes literary criticism in journal articles and book chapters. To locate the items you find in MLA:

- ✘ if it’s a journal article, click on ‘Linked Full Text’ or ‘Find it@UGA’
- ✘ if it’s a book article (chapter), look in the ‘Source’ field to find the book title, then go into GIL and search for the book title

Background & Biographical Information

Literature Resource Center (GALILEO): Contains biographies of authors.

Oxford Dictionary of National Biography (GALILEO): Contains biographies of notable Britons.

Oxford English Dictionary (GALILEO): Traces the history of words in English.

Full-Text Literature

Early English Books Online (GALILEO): Allows searching of almost every book and pamphlet published in Britain and her colonies between 1475 and 1700.
