Books

GIL, the UGA Libraries' Catalog <<http://gil.uga.edu>>: Lists books, journal subscriptions, and media materials in the Main and Science libraries at UGA.

GIL, the Universal Catalog <<http://giluc.usg.edu>>: Shared catalog for the University System of Georgia. Use this to request books from other libraries when we don't own the book or our copy is checked out.

GIL Search Tips

- ◆ To find critical or biographical materials about an author, choose 'Exact Search' and do a 'Subject Heading' search for the author's name.
- ◆ For other subjects, or to combine topics, use the 'Keyword Search.'

For example:

Eliot *and* Waste Land
English poetry *and* modernism
American poetry *and* 20th century *and* politics
National characteristics *and* Britain *and* 20th century
Ireland *and* intellectual life *and* 20th century


Also try variations using the "any of these" option:

fifties 1950s 50s

All of the databases listed below are available through GALILEO <<http://www.galileo.usg.edu>>. If you are searching from off campus, you will need the current password which is available from your account in GIL.

Articles

MLA International Bibliography (1926-present): Major index to literary criticism published in articles, book chapters, and dissertations.

- ***If you are working on a recent poet, or not finding enough on your topic, change the option from Specific Databases to Literature Databases.***
- *For articles without a full-text link, click on the  box to locate it online or in the library*
- *To locate book chapters, search GIL for the book title (found under Source on the MLA screen)*

JSTOR: Collection of full-text scholarly journals from the journal's first issue through five years ago. Also try **Project Muse** for a smaller collection of more recent scholarly journals.

LION (Literature Online): Supplements the MLA Bibliography by covering some journals not in MLA. Once in LION, choose 'Criticism & Reference.'

Periodicals Index Online (1770-1990): Index to tables of contents for older American, British, and European scholarly journals in the arts, humanities, sciences, and social sciences.

- *Searches only tables of contents, so keep the search very simple (i.e., book title or author's name)*
- *Use the Keyword search box at the top of the screen*
- *Be sure to limit by date if you want articles from a certain time period*

Newspapers

New York Times Historical Full Text (1851-2003)

LexisNexis Academic (approximately 1980-today): Full text of newspapers from the U.S. and Britain. Coverage dates vary depending on paper.

Literary Texts

LION (Literature Online): Searchable database of literary works. Once in LION, choose "Authors" to see if the database has poems by your author.

Book Reviews

Periodicals Index Online and the newspapers are also good sources for book reviews.

Biographies

Literature Resource Center: Includes the *Dictionary of Literary Biography*, *Contemporary Authors*, and other encyclopedias with short biographies of writers.

Oxford Dictionary of National Biography: Biographical dictionary of major figures in British history and culture.

American National Biography: Biographical dictionary of major figures in U.S. history and culture.
