## Book Sources

The catalog for UGA's books, journal subscriptions, media materials, and some of our manuscript holdings.

**GIL, the Universal Catalog** <<http://giluc.usg.edu>>

The shared catalog for the University System of Georgia. Use this to request books from other libraries when UGA doesn't own the book, or our copy is checked out or is otherwise unavailable.

**WorldCat** *In GALILEO under News/Facts/Reference→Books*

Most libraries in the U.S. list their holdings here, which makes it the most comprehensive book catalog available. Many libraries have begun listing their archival collections in WorldCat, too.

### *History*

**America: History & Life**, 1964-present

The major index to journal articles on the history of the U.S. and Canada.

### *Literature*

*In GALILEO under Arts & Humanities→Literature, Language & Criticism*

**MLA International Bibliography**, 1926-present

The most comprehensive index to journal articles and book chapters in literature, language, and folklore. Change 'Specific Databases' to 'Literature Databases' to add in results from **Academic Search Premier** (description below).

## ***Sociology***

*In GALILEO under Social Sciences → Sociology*

### **Sociological Abstracts, 1963-present**

Since this is an index to sociology journals, it can be a good source for researching ethnic studies from a social sciences viewpoint.

## ***Multidisciplinary***

*In GALILEO under 'Databases A-Z'*

### **JSTOR**

A collection of full-text scholarly journals from the first issue to approximately 2001.

### **Project Muse**

Similar to JSTOR, but a different collection of full-text journals and covering more recent years (usually mid-1990s to present).

### **Ethnic Newswatch, 1980-present**

Articles from the American ethnic and native press, with a selection of related scholarly journals, too.

### **Academic Search Premier, mid 1980s-present**

An index to scholarly and popular articles, many with full-text links.

## ***Latin American Studies***

*In GALILEO under 'Databases A-Z'*

### **Hispanic American Periodicals Index (HAPI), 1970-present**

An index to periodicals from the U.S., Mexico, Central and South America, and the Caribbean.

### **Informe!**

Includes the full text of popular Spanish-language and bilingual magazines, plus the Miami newspaper *El Nuevo Herald*.

A subject index to manuscript collections throughout the U.S.

### **African American Biographical Database**

A collection of short biographies reproduced from biographical dictionaries mostly published before 1950.

### **American National Biography**

The mainstream biographical dictionary for deceased Americans.
