

## Get References from JSTOR in GALILEO®

JSTOR contains only full text journal articles. However, there is a moving wall of unavailable content. The moving wall varies with each title, but in general the most current 3-5 years of a title are not in JSTOR.

Conduct your search in JSTOR, and save the items you want to retain by clicking the *Save Citation* link under each citation.

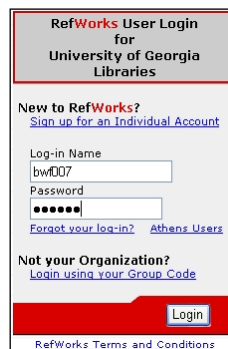
When done, click the *View Saved Citations* link above the screen's first citation, and on the right.



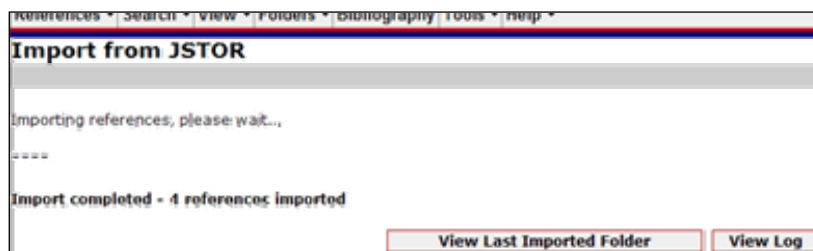
On the *Export Options* page, click the *Directly export citations into RefWorks*.



When prompted, login into RefWorks.



Your JSTOR citations are placed in the *Last Imported* folder in RefWorks. Click *View Last Imported Folder* to **move them** into another folder..



References left in *Last Imported* will be copied to *References Not in a Folder* the next time you import. Move them to one of your other folders.
