



2020 Undergraduate Research Award Application Checklist

Eligibility:

To be eligible for consideration, applicants must:

- be currently enrolled undergraduates during spring 2020 at any class level and in any discipline (arts, humanities, social sciences, sciences) at the University of Georgia;
- schedule and attend a library research conference with a UGA librarian before completion of the project. It is strongly encouraged that you allow time to incorporate the librarians' suggestions into your research and essay. <http://www.libs.uga.edu/researchaward/conference>
- agree to contribute to a display about their research mounted for public exhibition following receipt of the award, and also agree to allow the addition of their essay to UGA's Institutional Repository (Athenaeum <http://athenaeum.libs.uga.edu/>)

Complete / submit the following:

- Meet with librarian for library research conference (be sure to bring the application form with you to the meeting)
- Application Form with librarian's comments and signature

- 750-1000 word (3-4 page) essay describing your research strategies and experience
- Project reference list/bibliography (or bibliography in progress if project is not yet complete), in proper citation format (Chicago, MLA, APA, Turabian, etc.)
- Final version of abstract (if available)

- Essay and application materials must be received by **March 19, 2020**
